But we get really excited when we find willing **and** able family members for our children so that we can reunite them. These family members are often unknown and impossible to find but we live for success stories with happy endings, and here is one.

Vanessa is our in-house private detective, when children are placed in our care, she will go out of her way to investigate each and every case. Recently this resulted with a young boy being reunited with his biological mother!!! Because of her tireless digging and relentless phone calls, Pison (pic attached) was reunited with his mother whose life circumstance had radically

changed and who was now desperate and ready to have her son back in her arms.

This was made possible because Vanessa was here to follow every lead, and not give up, and that is only possible because our supporters help keep her in place and our doors open.
